A few points that students must note before they complete the on-line form:

- Students should not opt for the same class more than once. For example, if they would like to attend 'Racing Simulator', they should only select it once on one day, and not on more than one occasion that it is listed.
- It is not an expectation that students attend every morning and afternoon; we want them to experience a degree of choice and a sense of the sixth form experience. However, positive engagement and substantial attendance is required.

Year 11 students do not have to wear uniform during Springfield's Sixth Form week. However, non-uniform should be reasonably smart and appropriate for school; shorts, vest-tops, garments with slogans and similar are not acceptable.

Students must sign in and out at main reception during the week. On first arrival students will be given a personalised identification lanyard which must be worn at all times whilst on site.

Students who have booked sessions will be provided with an identity badge / lanyard which they will be expected to wear at all times while on site (these will be handed out when you sign in). The canteen will be open to Year 11 students at 11am and 1.15pm as usual.
