Springfield has high expectations of its students; we encourage every member of the school community to 'aim for excellence' in and enjoy all areas of school life. The pursuit of excellence underpins everything that we do. Our students consistently attain good GCSE results across the subject range, as well as other qualifications. We were proud of our Year 11 pupils' outcomes and future destinations last summer. Notably, 67% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in an English GCSE and 62% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in the mathematics GCSE. 54% of the year group achieved five or more GCSE passes including English and mathematics; and 38% of students achieved a strong pass (grade 5 or above – approximately equivalent to the former grade B) in English and mathematics. Top performing subjects were Triple Science and Statistics, with 95% of the students achieving a grade 4 or above.

We have an engaging, broad and balanced curriculum, which promotes sport, science, the arts and languages. A range of qualification routes is on offer at Key Stage 4 including GCSE, BTEC and applied options. Our students' performance in the English Baccalaureate GCSEs is impressive, with Springfield consistently entering more students for the EBacc than the national average. In 2025, 54% of students were entered for EBacc, compared with a national average of 41%.
